

# The Ihanzu language and cultural archive: an overview

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The archived collection of Harvey 2019 is the result of a large, multimedia documentation of Ihanzu language and cultural material. This talk 1) provides an overview of the contents of this collection, 2) gives examples of how the collection can be searched and interpreted, and 3) suggests some ‘threads’ running through the collection that might be fruitful for future exploration. In describing the collection, it is hoped that researchers from other disciplines (both linguistic and beyond) can better suggest ways in which the materials therein might be used, better understood, and enriched.
